*Additional projects may be added to this list at a later date. If you have knowledge or expertise in any of these areas, please come with your tools, ladders, yard tools, or anything you feel can help get the jobs done. We could use a big truck to load and haul off trash and debris. If you have one available let me know. Cleaning supplies will be provided. Please call Jan Squires if you or your church group can attend the CYC workday (910-520-0303). Let me know what projects you can help with. Thank you for helping!*

Deep cleaning projects throughout the camp facilities.

Yard cleaning projects such as raking, picking up debris around the campus, pulling up old bushes, cleaning up the brick piles, etc.

Possible: Build bleachers (if we can get the metal risers)

Redo plumbing at horse barn

Treat corral fence with wood preserver

Holder Dorm Projects: Replace or fix handle on Holder Dorm entrance door / Replace broken or missing Wall outlet covers / Install new soap and/or paper towel holders (if we get them)  
Patch sheetrock in Holder Dorm cabin 2 & 3, GR Baths, back door wall / Replace or put in doorstops  
In cabins 2 & 3 / Replace AC filters in Great Room / Replace any light bulbs that are out  
Replace termite damaged baseboards in Holder Dorm in cabin 2 & 6  
Replace or fix doorstops in Holder Dorm / Take down broken paper towel holders  
Tighten or replace clothesline wire / Fix or replace drain spout out front

Dining Hall projects: Take down folding doors at pantry entrance and put up a wall and door /  
Replace 2 wood side doors with casings and paint / Paint inside of opposite doors /  
Cover bathroom ceilings and ends of sink with wall board. / Replace outlet cover in pantry room /  
Take down wood cabinet in kitchen & put up wall board & set up new storage cabinet /  
Install magnetic cabinet closures in cabinets that won't stay shut / Pull out washer & dryer and clean &  
Check for lint build up / Replace or fix knobs on kitchen sink / Repair front stage wall & paint

Fix closures on dining hall doors / reset deadbolt locks / clean limbs & leaves off roof around AC unit /  
Attach the cooler compressor panels to wall behind dining hall / Pressure wash the wall & window under the porch

X Building projects: Take down toilet paper holders / Install soap and/or paper towel dispensers (if we have them) / Paint wood vent base in all showers / Patch holes in sheetrock in cabin 10 closet /  
Repaint the bottom of all showers / There are some issues with hot water heater in cabin 14 / Possible Painting cabins 14 & 16

Replace broken rail pickets on gazebo & strengthen rafters in certain areas

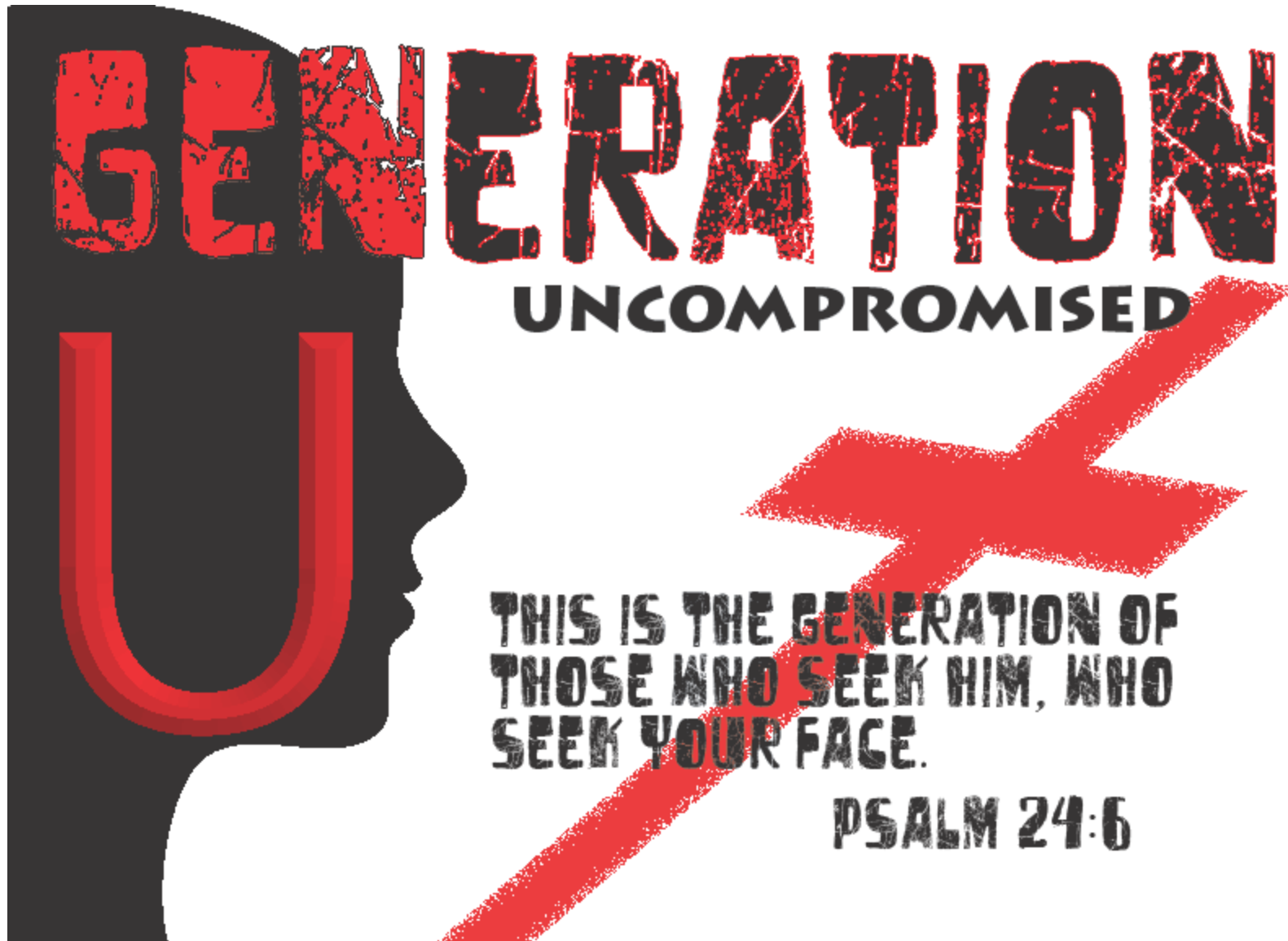
Fix water spigot leak outside Rec Room.

Cabin 15: Frame out back window (inside)

Cabin 25: Replace doorknob

Cabin 27: Drop down porch roof to prevent any further leaking of water into the walls
