2011 In Review



It's hard to believe that we are coming to the end of 2011. For me, it's hard to believe I am coming to the end of my first year as Director

of Christian Life Ministries. Over these past 10 months, a couple of activities have occupied much of my time and have impacted me:

Church Visits - First, I have enjoyed traveling from church to church and preaching to a different congregation every Sunday. It's been good to get reacquainted with communities, and churches, and especially with the people who make up our denomination. What I've noticed is that the churches that make up the PFWB are as diverse and distinct as the people who attend them. I have preached in some of our larger churches and in some of our smaller ones. I've preached in churches in rural areas and churches in more populated towns and cities. Some had a traditional style of worship and some a more contemporary style. But what has blessed me has been to see those values that unite us; values like the Lordship of Christ, the power of God's word, the presence of the Holy Spirit in our midst, a willingness to work and a desire to serve, and a heart for the hurting and the hopeless. These are the things that bind us together. These are what

make us PFWB, and Gwen and I have been blessed to experience this across the denomination. If I have not yet had the opportunity to visit your church, I'd like to, maybe in the coming year.

Meetings With Pastors - I have also enjoyed getting better acquainted with our pastors. Having been a pastor myself for the past 25 years, I have a special love and appreciation for what they do. As I have sat down with pastors across our denomination, sometimes one on one, sometimes in small groups, I've come to the conclusion that we have some of the finest pastors anywhere. They are men & women of integrity. They love their local church and are loyal to their denomination, and they make me proud to be PFWB. Throughout this year, I have been reminded that our pastors are on the front lines where the real ministry is happening and where this battle will be one or lost. I am honored to serve you in any way I can. Thank you, pastors for all of your input and ideas and for your prayers for me in my new role. I hope we can spend some quality time together in 2012.

Working With Teams - Thirdly, it has been my privilege to work closely with two teams this year; a task force, and an advisory council. Our CLM Task Force has met regularly with me this

year for the purpose of brainstorming and strategizing. Our primary task has been developing a discipleship plan to help churches grow spiritually and numerically. We plan to introduce our plan at the Arby Carter Memorial Lectures in February. Our CLM Advisory Council has also met regularly with me to offer guidance and council for the future of our ministries. They assist me in giving leadership and oversight to five key areas; Men's Ministry, Women's Ministry, Youth Ministry, Children's Ministry, and Sunday School. In 2012 we will be expanding these teams to include more people as we continue our work.

Serving With The Staff - Finally, I have been blessed to serve alongside a great staff at our Resource Center. I want to thank Dr. Preston Heath, our General Superintendent, for affording me this opportunity to serve, and Amy Murphy, my personal assistant, for all of her help this first year. Thanks to Dock Hobbs & Charles Heath for helping to show me the ropes, & thanks to Cathy, Deanna, and Paula for helping me find my way around the office!

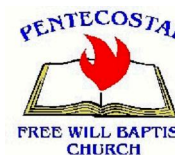

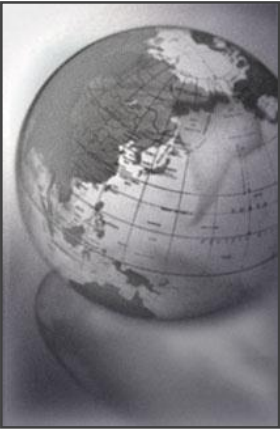
AMONG OUR MINISTERS AND CHURCHES—
